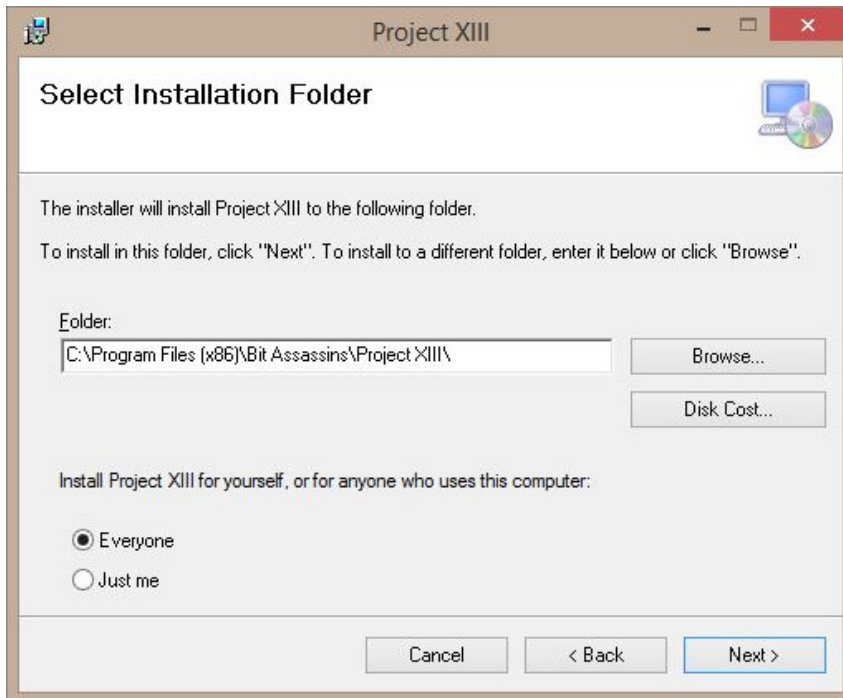
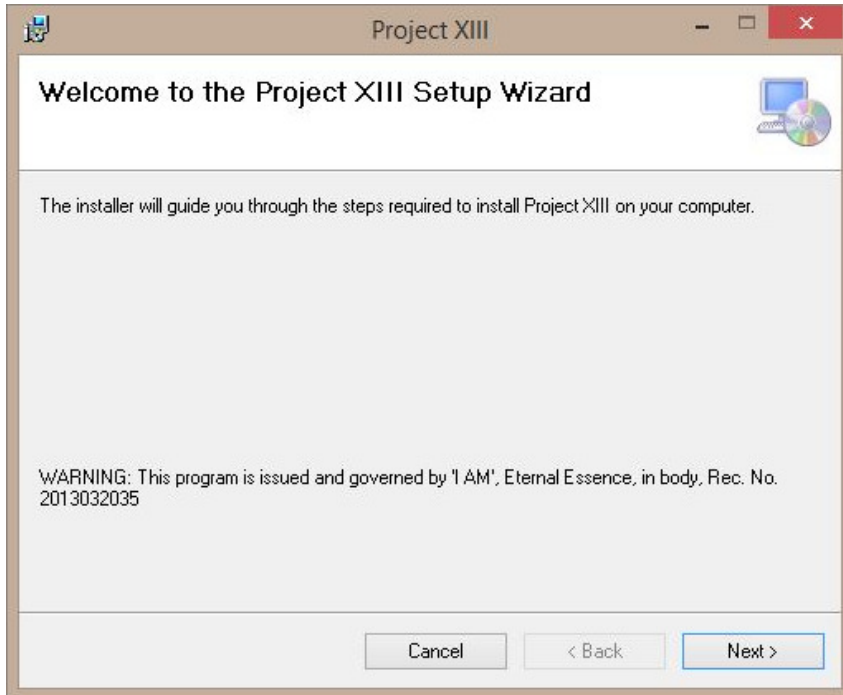
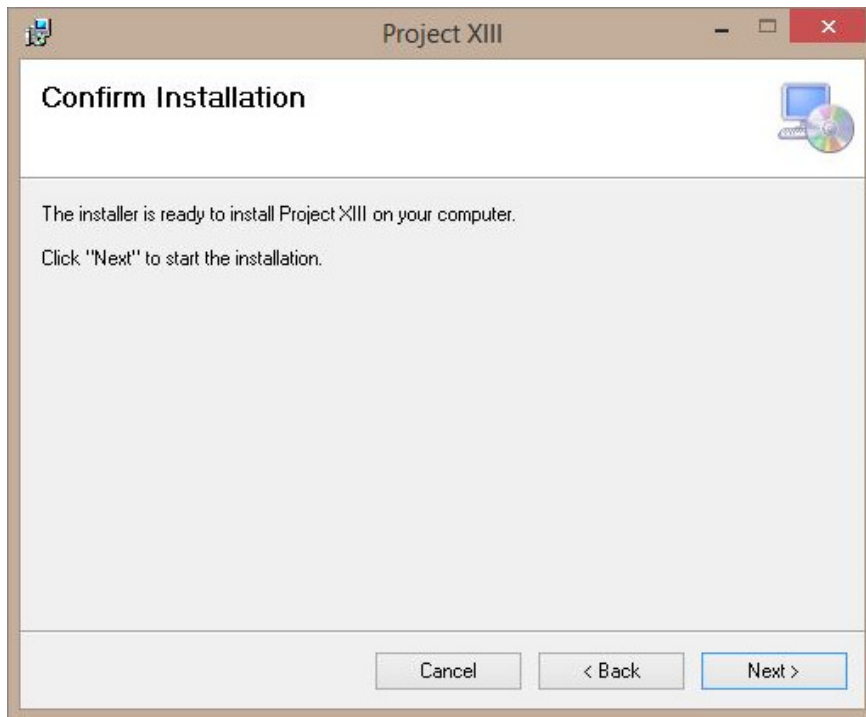


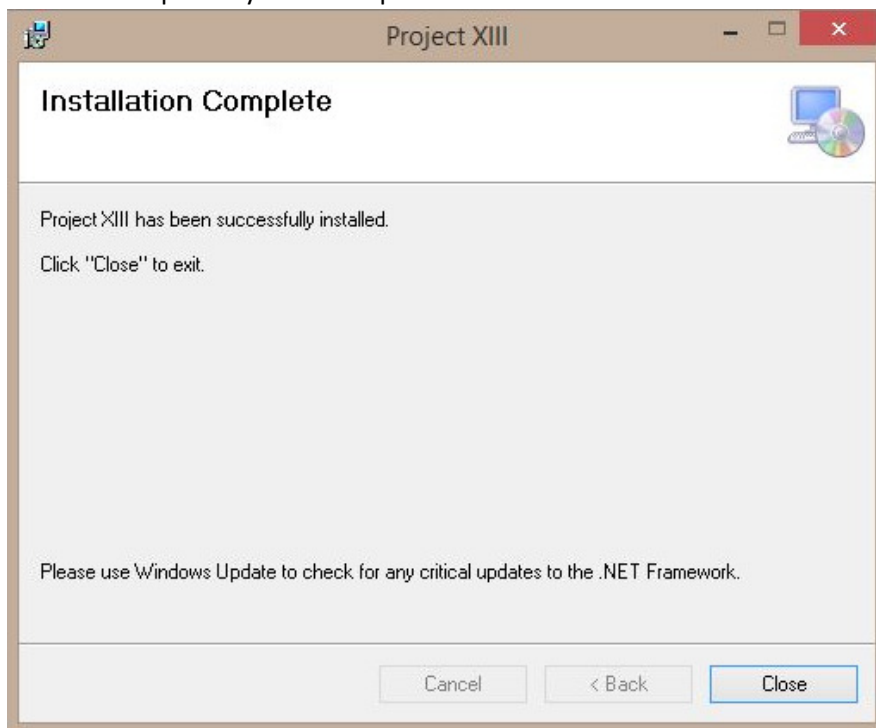


Project XIII is a Silverlight application. It runs out of the browser; and can be installed as a desktop application. After downloading the .zip that contains the ProjectXIII.msi & SocketServerSetup.exe you will need to extract those files to a location that you can remember. Double click on the ProjectXII.msi. Follow the presented prompts.

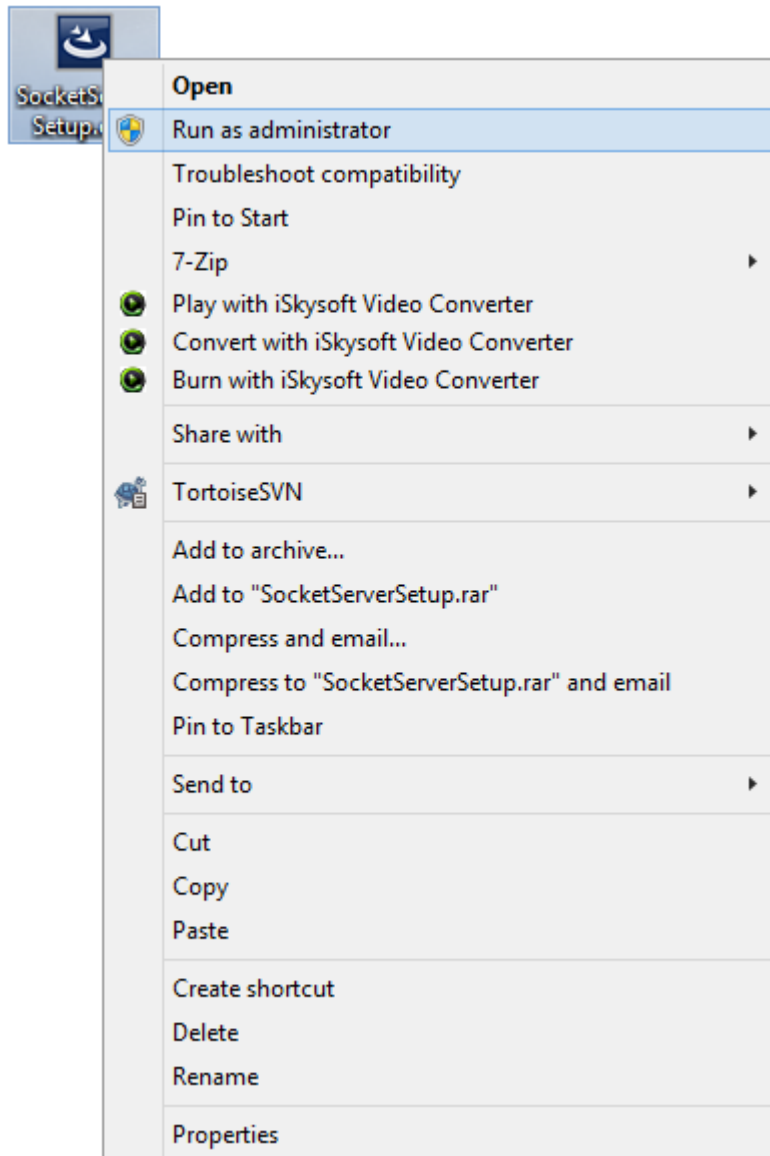




Clicking next here will result in a window that will show you the progress of the installation. When the install is completed you will be presented with the below screen.



The second component of the installation is the socket server. Project XIII uses a local socket server to manage peer to peer connections. If you have the Socket Server currently installed you will have to un-install it using 'Add or Remove Programs.' When you are ready to install it make sure that you have extracted the .exe from the .zip folder. Locate the SocketServerSetup.exe and right click on it. Select 'Run as Administrator' from the dropdown.





Follow the prompts to install the Socket Server. The installation process creates a Windows Service. It's set to start automatically.
